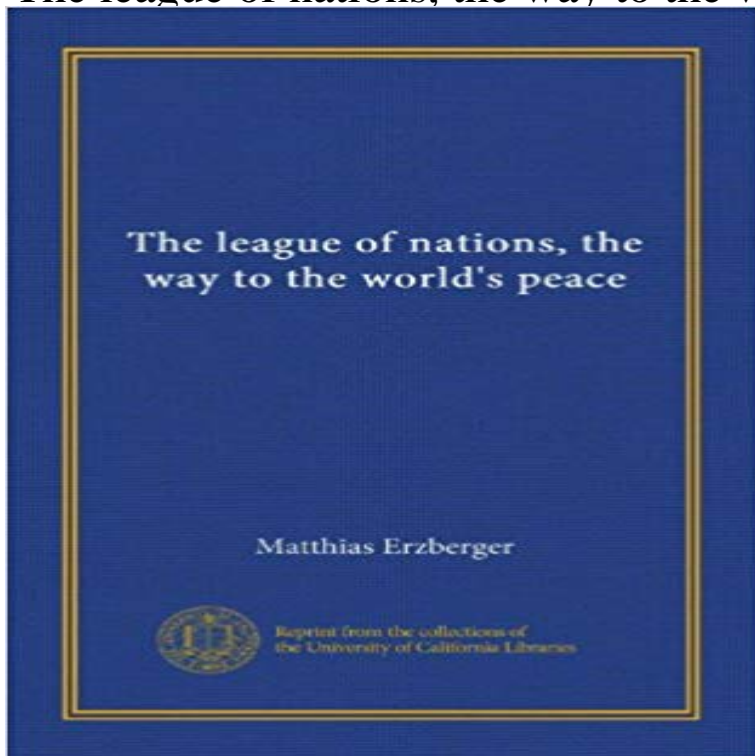


The league of nations, the way to the worlds peace
