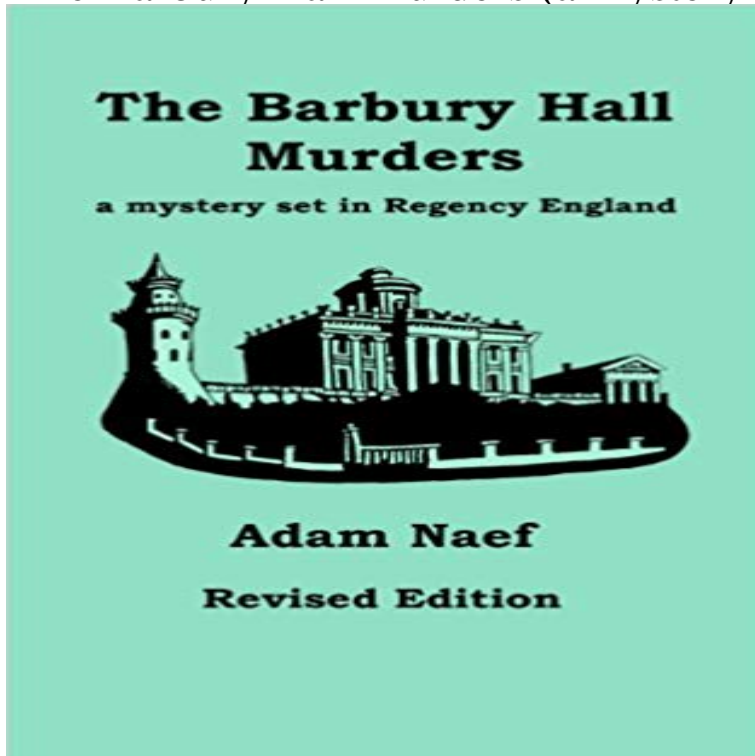


The Barbury Hall Murders (a mystery set in Regency England)
