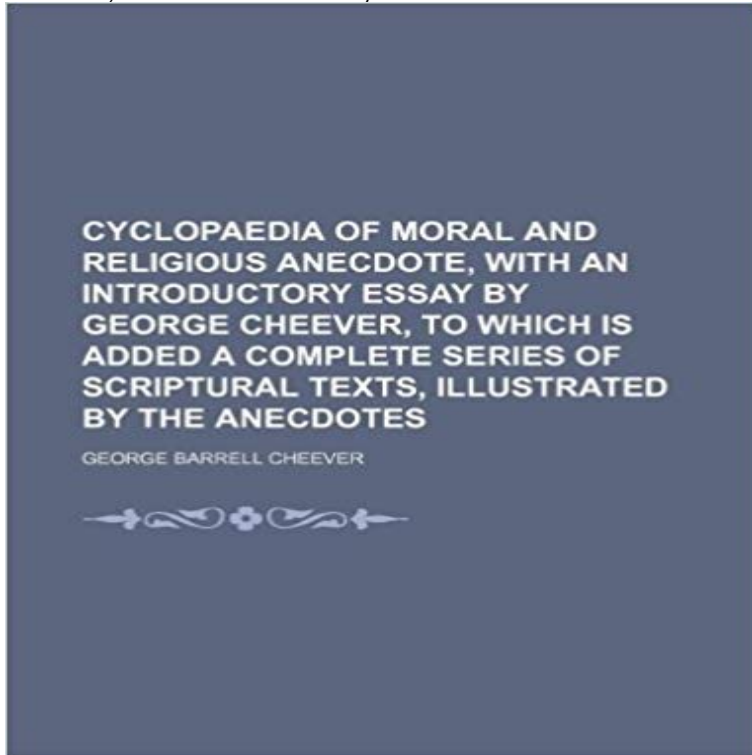

He directed a label to be attached to his breast when dead, with the admonition, Remember the words which I spake unto you while I was yet present with you; that they might be read by all who came to look at his corpse, and by which he, being dead, still spoke.
