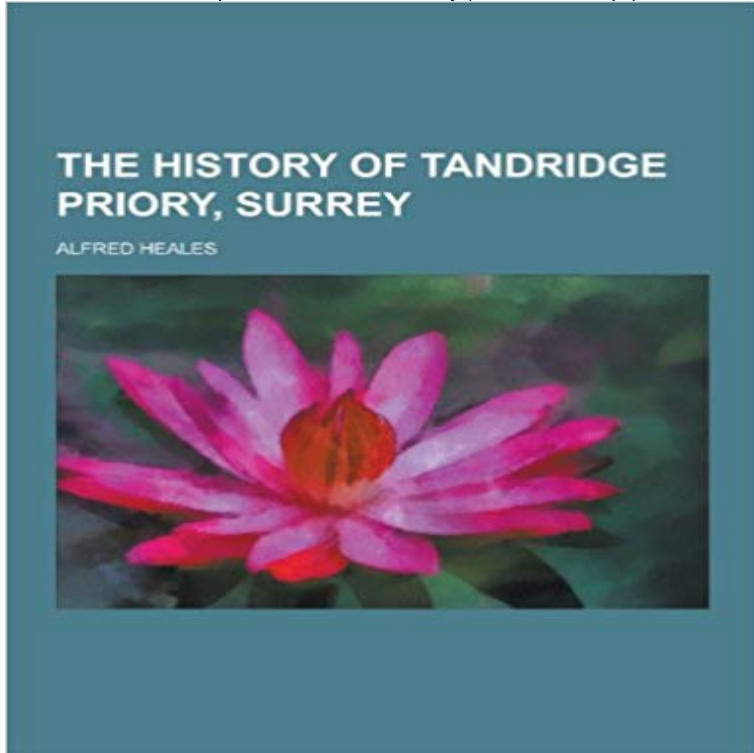


# The history of Tandridge Priory, Surrey
