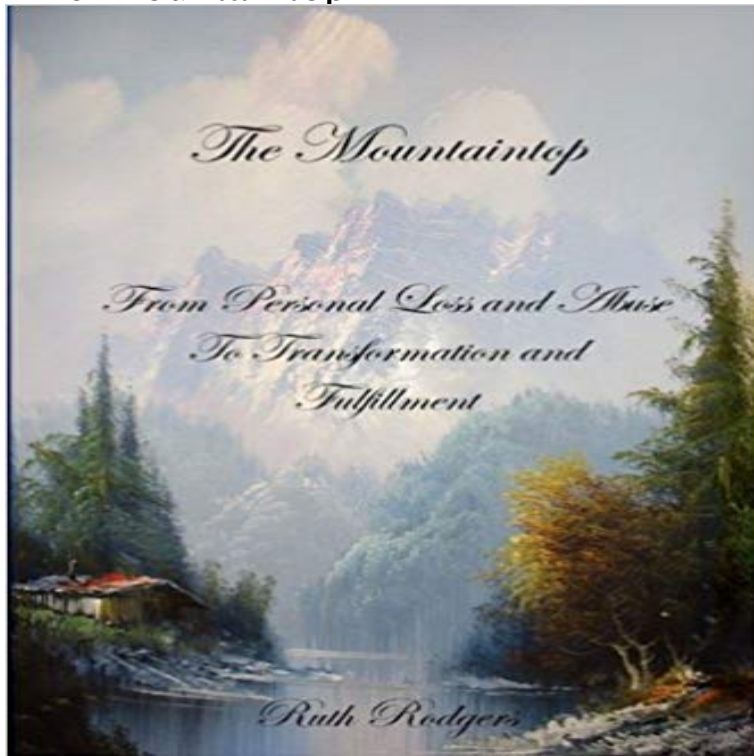


# The Mountaintop
