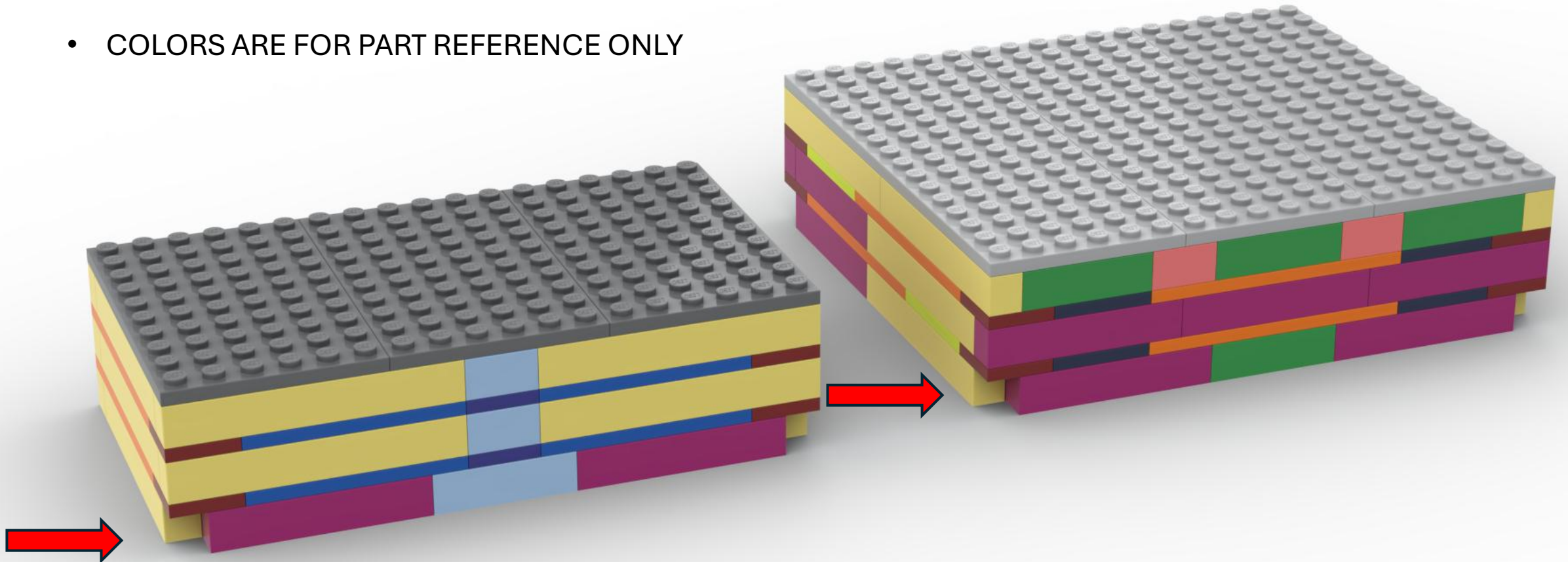
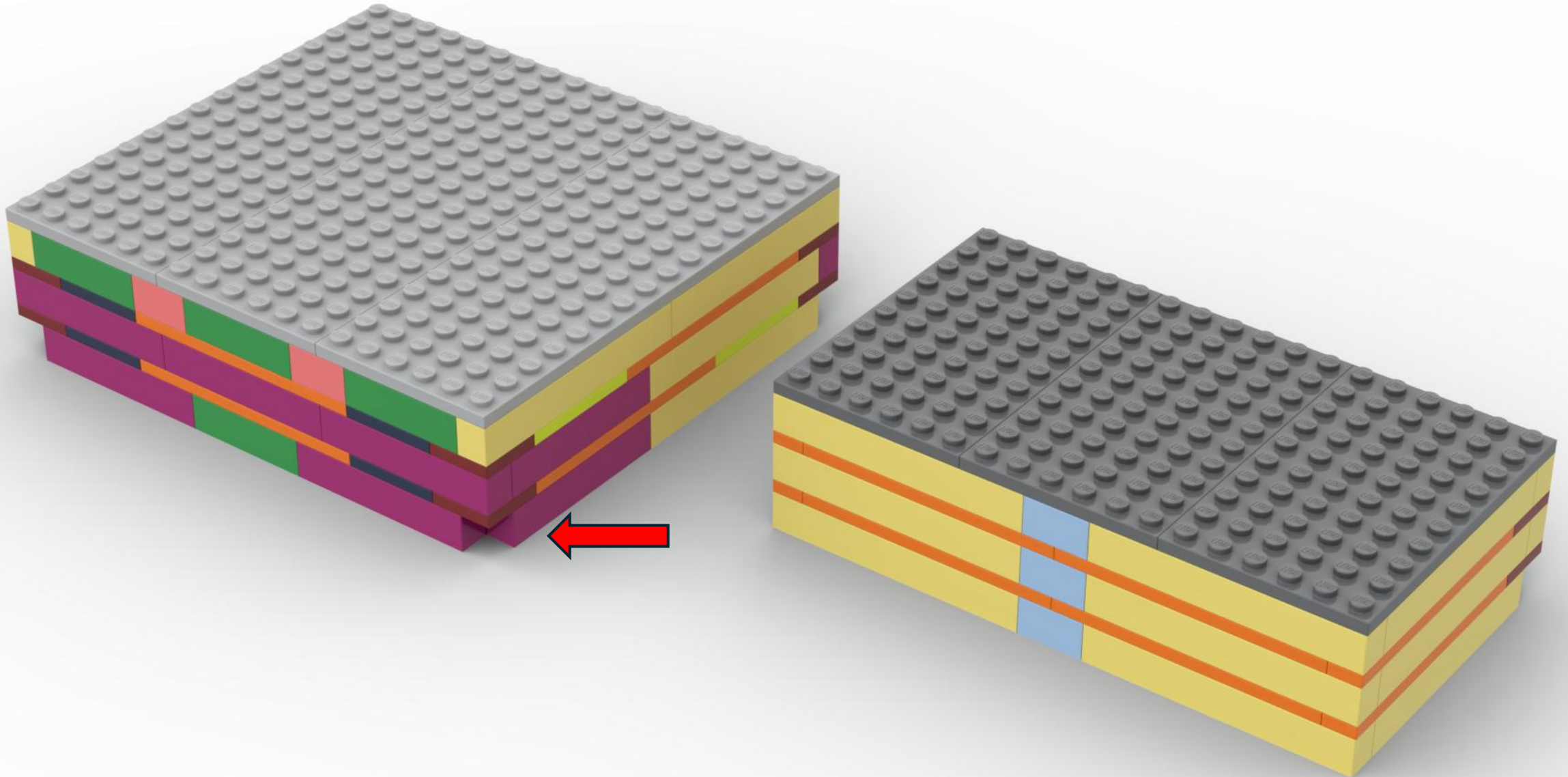


The Builtmor Theatre set standard is fairly flexible. This is intended to show size and important details for their use in the Theatre.

- All sets must be 18 studs wide.
- Stage depth can be as little as 6 studs, with 10 (shown below) being typical.
- Max stage depth is 16 studs (shown below) which is normally used for a double sided (two scene) build.
- Height should be 3 bricks and 3 plates (as shown).
- Note the notch at the front. This is required to slot into the fit into the theatre bumpers.
- COLORS ARE FOR PART REFERENCE ONLY



- The back side can be open or closed as needed.
- If preparing a double sided (two scene) build both sides should be closed, and notches are required on both sides (as below)



- The back wall of a scene can be flat or built out as needed.
- Height should range between 11 bricks to 16 bricks high.
- A line of tile at the top is an aesthetic choice.
- An additional layer of tile (or plates) should go on top of the base to be the “stage floor.”
- The space below the stage can be used to house battery boxes and mechanisms to add lighting or movement to these scenes.
